

Epidemiology, vaccines, and the life of the church - Tony Pearce

Another rather alarming disclosure which has come my way is the testimony of one doctor Vanden Bossche. I don't know if anyone's heard of this man. He's a Belgian doctor. He's actually worked on vaccines. He's even worked with the Bill Gates Foundation and with the Vaccine Alliance so, he's not an anti-vaxxer. He knows what he's talking about and he's written a letter to the World Health Organization asking them to stop all COVID vaccination programs immediately. He said, I'll quote what he says:



"One could only think of very few other strategies to achieve the same level of efficiency in turning a relatively harmless virus into a bioweapon of mass destruction." He also says: "We risk creating a global uncontrollable monster." His concern rests on what he calls "immune escape" stating that multiple emerging, much more infectious viral variants are already examples of 'immune escape' from our innate immunity. He says these are most likely created by government interventions already,

including lockdowns and facial coverings. He believes that, quote: "Ongoing mass vaccination deployments are highly likely to further enhance adaptive immune escape as none of the current vaccines will prevent replication transmission of viral variants as such. The more we use these vaccines for immunizing people in the midst of the pandemic, the more infectious the virus will become, and with increasing infectiousness comes an increased likelihood of viral resistance to the vaccines." 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
In other words, your own innate ability to resist will be broken down as a result of taking the vaccines. He says his beliefs are based on basic principles taught in the student's first vaccinology crisis class. He says one shouldn't use these kind of vaccines in populations exposed to high infectious pressure which is now certainly the case as multiple high infectious variants are circulating.

His real worry though or, as he puts it, "beyond worried", is that the human kind may severely damage its own natural innate immunity because of the mass deployment of vaccination programs. At this critical juncture, our innate immunity would be lost. It would also mean that vaccine-mediated protection would be lost while new, more very dangerous variants, would be getting actively bred in mankind. And he concludes: *"In effect, this would turn a relatively harmless virus into a bioweapon of mass destruction."*

I don't if you followed all that. I mean, obviously, he's got some technical terms and medical terms, but I say he's not a person who knows nothing about this. He's a person who's well-skilled in the in the matter and he says that it could turn up into being a mass disaster and that people would actually die as a result of having the vaccine. Then, they'd be infected by the new strains and they'd be more likely to suffer from it.

Obviously, the government and the media, and most medics reject this view, and they're encouraged just to take the vaccine. Saying *'it's perfectly safe, it's the answer to the pandemic and the only way out of the lock down'*. On one level, I hope they're right and that Dr Vanden Bossche is wrong because if he's right and they're wrong, then, we're actually heading for something pretty terrible coming down the line, something which could end up with a mass reduction of the world population; and someone said that's what they're aiming at anyway.

Well that remains to be seen and I have no knowledge of this subject myself, so I'm just quoting what somebody else says but it strikes me that he is a man who knows what he's talking about and he may have a point.

If he does have a point, then the world's in trouble and the vaccine may actually give a temporary relief, but when something else comes along, it may actually lead to much greater problems .

So what's to be done? Well, if we are Bible believers, we recognize a lot of this fits in with the progress towards the end time scenario kind of society

which we see emerging in the **Book of Revelation**, in the Great Tribulation period, and particularly, in the one-world government of the Antichrist leading to the Mark of the Beast system.

To be honest, our only hope is in the coming of the Lord and I believe that Jesus is coming. But we don't know when Jesus is coming, and **we don't know the day or the hour** of His coming. And He may come soon or it may be sooner or later, we don't know the day or the hour. Many people believe He's going to come in the next 10 years. It's possible but 'we don't know the day or the hour' so, we have to be ready for His coming and we have to continue to function in the kind of society which we see existing and shaping up

And when I look at what's happening now, I can see two possible outcomes:


One is that the government strategy versus the virus actually works temporarily and provides a time of peace and safety before the next wave of trouble hits us.

If you take the pre-Tribulation view of prophecy as I do, then there is going to be a time before the Rapture takes place when it appears that society is functioning as normal. In **Luke's** account, where he speaks about the Lord coming, **one's taken and one's left** He says. Likewise, as it was in the days of Lot, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they built but on the day that Lot went out of Sodom, it rained fire and brimstone from Heaven and destroyed them all. And also in the days of Noah they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage until the day that Noah went into the Ark.

All of those things are what's happening in normal life. So, one thing which occurs to me is that we could see a return to something relatively normal. People will think it's okay. We got peace and safety now, and Boom! Sudden destruction comes or actually, even the Rapture comes.

That throws another whole scenario into the situation. It does mean that the present round is a kind of 'trial run' for something bigger which is going to come down the road to 'soften people up' so they will accept the world government.

What are we going to do about it ?

The other possibility of course, is that it doesn't work and the scenario given by Dr Vanden Bossche leads to mass disaster, to the Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse riding out, to war, famine, death, and the events of the Great Tribulation are the end result.

Either way, the only hope is in Jesus. If you hope in the pre-Tribulation Rapture as I do, you may have to go through some time of trouble first, and we need to be ready for that. We need to be ready that we are recognized.

Also, we're living in a time of increasing trouble and of control over our lives by an alien, anti-Christian system in which most of us have what we've known as freedom of conscience, freedom of speech, freedom of movement, and assembly removed.

We want to stay alive, we want to be able to meet with people, with friends, to have fellowship with the Lord. Also, we want to be able to preach and teach the Gospel.


So, we've got to work out how we're going to do what we recognize the COVID crisis has actually raised a question over. We hope we may be coming out of it, but it may be a false storm before the next crisis hits. As I said, in the coming crisis, we may really lose all of our freedom and even lose our lives.

Of course, if we are Christians, if you believe in Jesus, losing your life is not the worst thing which can happen to you because, if you die, you go to be resurrected and to be with the Lord, and you've opened up the way to a glorious new life in the resurrection body with the Lord. At the same time, the Lord wants us to stay alive and to use as long as possible our life for His purpose.

Secondly, we have to recognize that the lockdown has put previously unknown restrictions on our ability to meet with friends, with family, even with strangers, which is part of our normal life and our life as believers in the fellowship of the Gospel, and in going out to preach the Gospel.

It has actually opened up new ways of communicating through Zoom and through the Internet, through live streaming services which have been effective and, in our case, have actually increased our membership and attendance at meetings. We've also developed new ways of multiplying our evangelism through distribution of leaflets, magazines, items on Facebook and Twitter etc.

But all these things are, in one sense, certainly not how the apostles did it. And we want to get back to the time when we can actually talk face-to-face with people, and preach the Gospel.

We also recognize there's a need for face-to-face meeting in the church, so that the church can be a place of community, a place where people meet and make friends, or we can pray for one another and support one another, but we can also remember the Lord in the breaking of bread, give thanks for what He's done for us, and we can receive the apostles' teaching, breaking of bread in fellowship and prayers.

The New Testament places great emphasis on the significance of the true church as the body of Christ. The place where we meet with Him, as Jesus said, **where two or three gathered together in my name, I'm there in the midst.** Hebrews tells us **not to neglect the assembling of ourselves together, more so, as you see the day approaches.**

As we see things developing in society, we should campaign that never again the government actually closes down churches and also that never again would churches meekly submit to these dictates. One of the things which I found quite shocking is that most churches, even though we have been allowed to meet over the last three months, have not done so, including evangelical churches, Bible-believing churches. They've kept it all on Zoom. I think that's a big mistake. I think that we should do what we can to meet together in person because that's part of what the body of Christ is all about. Even though the government has not forbidden churches to meet, many churches have actually taken it upon themselves to forbid to meet; especially, the Church of England has closed down its buildings.

Incidentally, the state has no right under law to forbid the meeting of churches going back to the Magna Carta, the laws passed after the Reformation and even the EU human rights laws.

We have opened of course, but we have opened with restrictions in place. Probably less than half the people are coming in person than used to come before all this started, although we've got many more coming on Zoom and Internet.

We hear of churches which have stopped all together and also, around the world, there has been attempts of governments to close down churches completely. Particularly in places where there is persecution like China. In China, they've also forbidden any Zoom and Internet meetings of the church, and even in the United States, we've seen instances where pastors have brought their churches together and have been attacked and stopped from doing so by local government.

We also see certain restrictions on what we can say and I'm going to say a bit more about that later. Particularly saying anything critical about homosexuality, transsexuality, even about Islam and so, we have increasing censorship taking place on what Christians are free to say.

We have to pray for wisdom to know what to do, how to move forward. I believe there's no question that we're moving towards a more dangerous and difficult society to live in. The question of the vaccines is what perplexes us at moment, but there are other things which are going to come down the line and we have to recognize that the world itself is in a very dangerous state. There are possible financial and social effects of the lockdown leading to the collapse of society.

Even last week, we've seen the disorder taking place in Bristol as people attacked the police and there's this anti-authority, anti-police situation. We saw it last year with the Black Lives Matter demonstrations and all this is actually heading towards the beginning of the breakdown of society.
