

## **Talk for 10 January. A study of Exodus 15.**

Israel's exodus from slavery in Egypt and our exodus from slavery to sin.

**Talk starts about 30 minutes into programme.**

### **What's in it?**

Exodus 15 – The first song in the Bible. Why we should praise God in all circumstances and give thanks for our deliverance. Praise God for who He is, what He has done and what He is going to do. Show our faith in Him as our Creator, Redeemer and Judge. Vital in bringing us through the wilderness.

Verse 2. The Lord is our salvation / Yeshua / Hebrew name of Jesus.

Verse 3. The Lord is a man of war. Israel's war in the physical realm a parallel to our war in the spiritual realm.

Revelation 19. The final war when Jesus returns to defeat the armies of the Beast and the False Prophet is a parallel to this defeat of Pharaoh and his armies.

Verse 6. Your right hand, O Lord, has become glorious in power. Right hand is associated with the power of the Lord. Also associated with the Messiah. Psalm 80, Daniel 7, Matthew 26.63-66 – Yeshua as the Messiah – the Man of Your right hand.

V 11 Who is like unto you. 'Mi kamocho'. Prayer of synagogue service. Asserting uniqueness of God. There is none like the Lord / God of Israel. Creator, Redeemer, Judge of all the earth. Unique and entirely different from idols of nations. Cannot be mixed with them. So too is Jesus - the only begotten Son of God, our Redeemer, Saviour and coming King and Judge.

Verse 11. Doing wonders. God is able to do signs and wonders at all times. However there are certain times in history at a change in the dispensation when God moves in some visible form doing powerful signs and wonders, intervening here on earth.

In the past = Creation, Fall, Flood, Exodus, coming of Messiah Yeshua.

In the future = 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming, End of the World / new heavens and new earth.

Most spectacular intervention yet to come (soon) in events of return of Messiah.

Last song in Bible = Revelation 16 – song of Moses and the Lamb, like the song of Exodus 15 - victory over the beast, glory to God, deliverance of God's people.

Verses 22-25. Bitter Waters Made Sweet. Back to earth. Israel now has no home, no water, no food, does not know where they are or where Moses is leading them. Begin to grumble. Come to waters of Marah – water bitter, made sweet by the tree being cast into the waters. Tree – cross – transforms the bitter water of our experience of life into the sweet water of salvation in Jesus.

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
